A Note from **Steuart Pittman** Anne Arundel County Executive



Our libraries connect us. They are in our neighborhoods, open to all, and safe.

That's why when our communities have challenges, I often turn to Skip Auld and his team for help. In our county, the libraries have stepped up — with covid test kit distribution, satellite centers for our workforce development and social service teams, locations for important community meetings, sites for residents to review county planning documents and provide feedback, and even electric vehicle charging stations. In Anne Arundel County, our libraries are our community

Last year, when we established the new joint initiative with our school system to

close the opportunity gap that causes so many kids to be left behind in school, I set a goal of increasing kindergarten readiness from its current level below 50% to 76% by the year 2026. I noted that the only way to get there would be an ambitious effort to reach younger children and their families, and to connect them with services.

The library team listened. They put their heads together and created a plan to connect with the most at-risk families through a new network of mobile library staff, and they called it the Kindergarten Readiness Outreach Program. They submitted a budget reguest of nearly \$662,000 to get the program started with six staff and two vehicles.

I listened back. The program made sense to me, and we figured out how to pay for it. The FY23 Budget Proposal that I submitted to the County Council on April 29 includes full funding for the program.

I look forward to working with our libraries, connecting them with all county departments, and continuing to deliver for the good families of our county. Together we truly can make Anne Arundel County The Best Place — For All.
